

Introduction

In 1994, KKMC published a Vision Statement (Vision 2000) on how the Lord was leading us as a congregation to grow in Him and bless others in our community and beyond our shores.

In 2019, the occasion of KKMC's 125th Anniversary is a time to

for God's faithfulness and provision for KKMC over generations. It is also a time of reflection on how we can continue to grow together as a joyful and loving family in Christ Jesus and bless one another, our neighbours and beyond, for generations to come.

My Prayers for KKMC

Brief History Of Kampong Kapor Methodist Church

1894	25 January. The Baba Malay Methodist Church was inaugurated at 155 Middle Road. This church was the result of the work of Miss Sophia Blackmore, an Australian Methodist Missionary and Captain William Shellabear. They were both concerned that there was no Methodist worship services in 'Baba Malay' the common language in Singapore during the 1890s. This was the fourth Methodist Church in Singapore.
1914	The Church held Sunday services in 5 languages, Hinghua, Baba Malay, Hakka, Foochow and English from 8am to 9pm. It had the largest Sunday School and Epworth League. The Middle Road building was overtaxed and in 1916, a Building Campaign was launched.
1930	The church relocated to Kampong Kapor Road and became known as The Straits Chinese Methodist Church.
1937	The pipe organ, built by Walker & Taylor was installed. It remains the first and only pipe organ in Singapore Methodist Churches.
1953	15 September. The Straits Chinese Methodist Church Kindergarten commenced enrolment.
1957	The church was renamed Kampong Kapor Methodist Church.

1965	A Christian Education Centre was added beside the sanctuary.
1985	The Mandarin Ministry was started.
1985 to 1986	The start of KKMC's modern missionary effort with the sending of Lynne Wee to Finland in 1985 and Patrick and Yin Heng to Taiwan 1986.
1987	Methodist Welfare Family Centre (renamed Kampong Kapor Family Service Centre, KKFSC, in 1991) opened at Block 640 Rowell Road.
1993	The Tamil Ministry was started.
1994	KKMC adopted Vision 2000: God's Challenge, Our Commitment to Grow, Glow, and Go. The fruits of Vision 2000 included a preaching point that became Cairnhill Methodist Church in 1998, the Lahu work (1998) and Feeding of needy migrant workers (1998).
2011	The Unfailing Light building was opened by Mr Earnest Lau.
2014 to 2018	Church Theme - In and Involved: About the Church, Along the Streets and Across the Seas adopted.
2019	125th Anniversary - New Vision Statement!
